European Team Championship to be held in 2007 - Consultation Process

Dear WCF and FEC Member Association,

I refer to the announcement made earlier today that The World Croquet Federation (WCF) in conjunction with the European Croquet Federation (FEC), is organising a European Team Championship to be held at Cheltenham, England in June 2007. This will feature both Association Croquet and Golf Croquet.

The format and length of the event are not at this moment decided. WCF and FEC want to take account of the views of all FEC member associations so that the event is attractive to as many countries as possible.

1. How many days should the team championship take (3,4,5 or 6)?
2. Best day to finish (Saturday or Sunday)?
3. Do you have any views on the format for each match and/or the event. (e.g. Teams of 3+ players, 1 game of Association (14pt or 26pt), 2 games Golf or 2 games of Association with one game of Golf)?
4. When would you like coaching to be held?

Can you please give consideration to this and let me know of any views you have.
